### **IMPORTANT NOTE**

# These Supplementary Regulations can only be used for Club Karting Competition at an Affiliated Karting Club in strict accordance with the requirements of all Federal and State Government COVID-19 mass gathering Orders and Directions. The Club must have completed and submitted to their SKA, their <u>COVIDSafe Action Plan</u> for all facilities.

#### COVID-19 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND VOLUNTARY ACCEPTANCE OF RISK
